You will have heard that these Games have now been cancelled completely. Liverpool Council had to pull out due to insufficient availability due to other events being rescheduled. I know that those of you who had put your names down to go will be disappointed, especially if you have been to Games before.

Due to the cancellation of the National Games in Liverpool, the deposits and first payments have now been refunded to the club.

Cardiff Chameleons Bowls Group Restart.

There have been no bowls training sessions since March 13th 2020 and I'm sure most of you will be itching to get back to training. Cardiff Indoor Club is starting to prepare for the return to Indoor Bowls.

Bowls Wales are in touch with the Welsh Assembly Minister for Sport and as soon as they get the go-ahead the guidelines will be published and issued to all Indoor Bowls facilities. A Covid-19 officer has been appointed and the required survey and risk assessments along with on-line training, will take place over the next couple of weeks. Hand Sanitizer stands have arrived at the club along with a Traffic light system, with temperature sensor and Track and Trace facilities. These will be in place by the time we return.

The Closest estimate for the return of Indoor Bowls at the moment is early October. If there is any change, I will update everyone as soon as possible.

As most of you are aware the Liverpool Games has now been cancelled. Refund cheques for those who were going to attend the games have now been issued and you should have received the refunds in full by the time the newsletter is sent out. We will be trying to fill the void by finding additional competition pathways, as well as the existing Regional, Welsh Championships and LDIBIS over the next few years.

Latest Update!!
