If you pay this you would be eligible to attend, for example, the NW Regional Gala (Cheshire Penguins) and any National Games. If you don't pay then you would only be able to attend our Club Gala, Bridgend Sharks and Pembrokeshire Puffins galas. If you (bowlers & swimmers) decide to "opt out" of Special Olympics and in the future you would like to resume, this is not an easy process. As their criteria is more complicated and can take a few years to be re-affiliated.

The bowlers are different as they attend mostly non SOGB events unless they attend a National Games or a Special Olympics Regional event to qualify for the National Games.
