Some of you might have seen Gareth Clark on the Welsh news about a group of actors from Hijinx going to Lesotho. Gareth's dad, Mike, has written the following outlining why they have gone.

GARETH'S VISIT TO LESOTHO

Gareth is one of four Hijinx Theatre actors with Downs Syndrome from across Wales who visited Lesotho from February $10^{th}-25^{th}$. The four learning disabled actors along with two professional actors from Hijinx are making the exciting visit to demonstrate that people with disabilities can contribute fully to society. In Lesotho disability is regarded as a real barrier and people with disabilities are rarely seen in public and children with disabilities are often abandoned by their families and left to grow up in orphanages.

During their stay in Lesotho, Hijinx will be rehearsing two inclusive pieces of theatre called "able to act "and "I aspire to be. " They will be working with students from Machabeng International College and Pheusanog Orphanage . They will then perform with the children and students in the open. Their first public performance was in front of 450 people.

Lesotho is twinned with Wales but this is the first time that a project of this nature has happened. Most of the funding has come from the Welsh Government through Hub Cymru and the British Council.

Gareth has been swimming in the lodge where they have been staying and so he has done some training although it was an outdoor pool in the middle of their winter!!

A follow up article will appear next month to see how Gareth & Co got on.
