Eastern Leisure Centre UPDATE

It is looking very unlikely that we will be returning to Eastern LC at the present time. They want to charge us $\pmb{\it E98.00}$ per hour to use the pool each week. Although we are trying to see if they will give it to us for less the only thing we can expect is, that in time, they will increase their fees. The other downside to this is that we would have to increase subs to more than the £3.00 we charged before.

In this respect, we have been sourcing other pools and Pamela has booked the pool at the **CMC Sports & Social Club** (UHW) where she works. They will charge us £45.00 an hour (less than half of Eastern). The only evening of the week the pool is available is on a **Thursday evening**.

Pamela has now booked further sessions for March; they are 3rd, 10th, 17th and 31st.

These sessions are from 8pm – 8.45pm (earlier than it was at Eastern LC).

The subs will stay at £3.00 per session and there is a room available for parents to go to whilst the session is going on plus free parking in the multi-storey car park opposite. This means (hopefully) the swimmers will return to having two sessions a week as the Sunday evenings will still carry on at Howells School. We had a few members from the Sunday sessions also attended on the Thursday and some may decide to just attend on the Thursday. This would lead to spaces being available on the Sunday sessions.

We only had **2** members who normally swam at Eastern L.C. return. It would be appreciated if people who used to attend at Eastern would let us know how they feel about these sessions and whether you are going to come back or not at all.

Some tremendous bowling was witnessed by over 90 Bowlers, Volunteers, Coaches and supporters. Bowlers from Pembroke, Radnorshire, Islwyn, Rhondda and Cardiff Chameleons, took part in round robin competitions in three separate classifications. The winner and runner-up in each Classification going on to the Semi-Finals and Finals to determine the Welsh Champions. The L3 Classification Semi-finals was an all Cardiff Chameleon affair. The final was between Sean Thackwray and Meilir Sion versus Paul Scott and Newcomer Mark Hosken with the latter pairing running out the Championship winners.
